# 2024 Year 10

## Trinity College students entering Year 10

- ☐ Study four elective units over the year.
- ☐ Can undertake one Unit 1 and 2 subject

## Accelerated entry to a VCE or VET subject

- ☐ not automatic – you need to apply
- ☐ based on careful examination of the student's academic progress throughout Year 9 and discuss with DOL
- ☐ based on teacher recommendations
- ☐ dependent on available places (students studying Year 11 are given first priority)

### VCE SUBJECTS

As senior students progress into their final years, they have the opportunity to choose between a variety of options to meet their pathway to tertiary studies or to seek employment.



#### RELIGION AND SOCIETY

Accreditation Period: 2023-2027

Explore the origins of religion and its role in the development of society, identifying the nature and purpose of religion over time.

■ **Unit 1:** The role of religion in society, identifying the nature and purpose of religion over time.

■ **Unit 2:** Religion and ethics.

■ **Unit 3:** The search for meaning looking at how religion can respond to the big questions of life.

■ **Unit 4:** Religion, challenge and change.  
Religious traditions or religious denominations are to be selected from Buddhism, Christianity, Hinduism, Islam, Judaism and Sikhism.



#### BUSINESS MANAGEMENT

Accreditation Period: 2023-2027

This subject leads to opportunities such as small business owner, project manager, human resource manager, operations manager or executive manager. Further tertiary study can lead to specialisation in areas such as marketing, public relations and event management.

■ **Unit 1:** Planning and developing a business idea.

■ **Unit 2:** Establishing a business. Includes understanding the legal and financial requirements, marketing and staffing.

■ **Unit 3:** Managing a business. Looks at business objectives and how to manage employees and operations effectively.

■ **Unit 4:** Transforming a business. Looks at the best way to change a business and improve performance.



#### LEGAL STUDIES

Accreditation Period: 2024-2028

Examines the institutions and principles that are essential to the Australian legal system, including understanding the rule of law, law-makers, legal institutions, the relationship between the people and the Australian Constitution, the protection of rights in Australia, and the Victorian justice system.

■ **Unit 1:** The presumption of innocence looking at criminal law.

■ **Unit 2:** Rights and wrongs looking at civil law.

■ **Unit 3:** Rights and justice such as fairness, equality and access.

■ **Unit 4:** The people, the law and reform.



#### HISTORY

Accreditation Period: 2022-2026

Examining people, groups, events, ideas and movements across history.

■ **Unit 1:** Investigate the foundations and features of empires and the significant global changes they brought to the wider world in the early modern period.

■ **Unit 2:** Modern History looking at the social, political, economic and cultural change in the later part of the 19th century and the first half of the 20th century.

■ **Units 3 and 4:** Revolutions, students explore the significant historical causes and consequences of political revolution, such as the Russian and French Revolution.



#### GEOGRAPHY

Accreditation Period: 2022-2026

Examine natural and human phenomena, how and why they change, their interconnections and the patterns they form across the Earth's surface.

■ **Unit 1:** Hazards and Disasters.

■ **Unit 2:** Tourism Issues and Challenges.

■ **Unit 3:** Changing the Land and land use.

■ **Unit 4:** Human Population Trends and Issues.

# Why would you consider acceleration?



## Personal Development:

- Improving time management and study skills for further VCE study
- Motivation and engagement
- Sense of achievement
- Gain confidence and experience for VCE expectations, preparation for assessments and exams

## Academic Challenge:

- Interest in specific subject or learning area
- Results and reports reflect readiness for accelerated subject
- Teacher recommendation for extension opportunity

Additional considerations include ATAR



# What you need to consider

## Commitments in Year 10:

- Consider your mix of Year 10 subjects and workload for these
- Require balancing of schoolwork, extracurricular activities, employment
- Commitment to regular Year 10 homework and additional homework for accelerated subject

## Subject Requirements:

- Some VCE subjects have benefits to complete Year 10 curriculum for additional skills and knowledge; some mathematics, music, some sciences

## Implications for subject Choice in Year 12:

- There may be a requirement to select an additional 3/4 subject in Year 12 without completing Unit 1/2

# Subject Pathway Interview



- Opportunity to discuss subject acceleration with allocated teachers
- Can discuss array of subjects that you are considering
- Essential to have the application completed PRIOR to the interview
- Come prepared with questions from either yourself or your parents
- Follow up and further research may be required

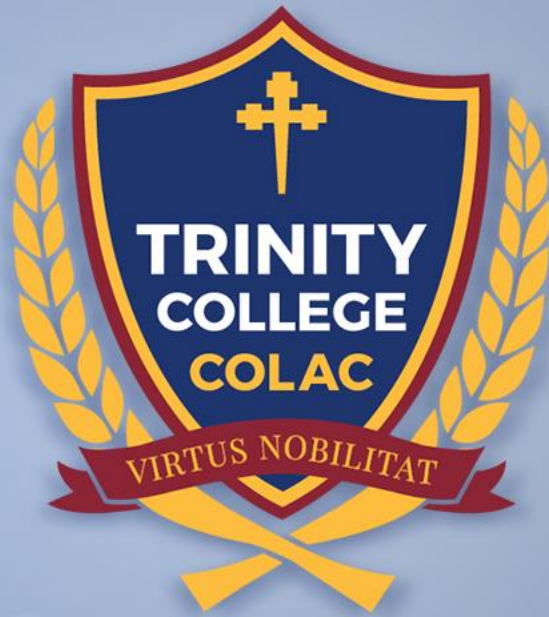

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# What is VET?

- Students in Year 10 may undertake a VET Course
- Accelerated Subject – must have approval from TCC
- Gives students a good insight into industries and many of our students move from a VET Course into a School Based Apprenticeship or Traineeship or full time employment
- Offers 'hands-on' practical training with less theory-based learning
- Students will gain skills required to move into the workforce
- Operates as part of VCE or VM Pathways
- Some courses may add to your ATAR
- Competency-based assessment – usually no exams
- Usually a 2-year course

# What you NEED to do!



## Current Y9 students wanting to do a VET Course need to be aware.

- VET off campus is chosen as an extra subject.  
No allocation can be made for this subject in the timetable, therefore schoolwork missed must be made up outside class time.
- Interested students MUST make an appointment with Mrs Julie Demasi (VET Coordinator) to discuss further.
- Current Year 9 students MUST complete the Accelerated VCE/VET Program Application Form
- **Costs** involved which is additional to school fees.
- Applications will open early August for external VET options
  - South West TAFE Colac – 4 August
  - The Gordon Geelong – 18 August
- Applications need to be completed as soon as possible as courses fill quickly

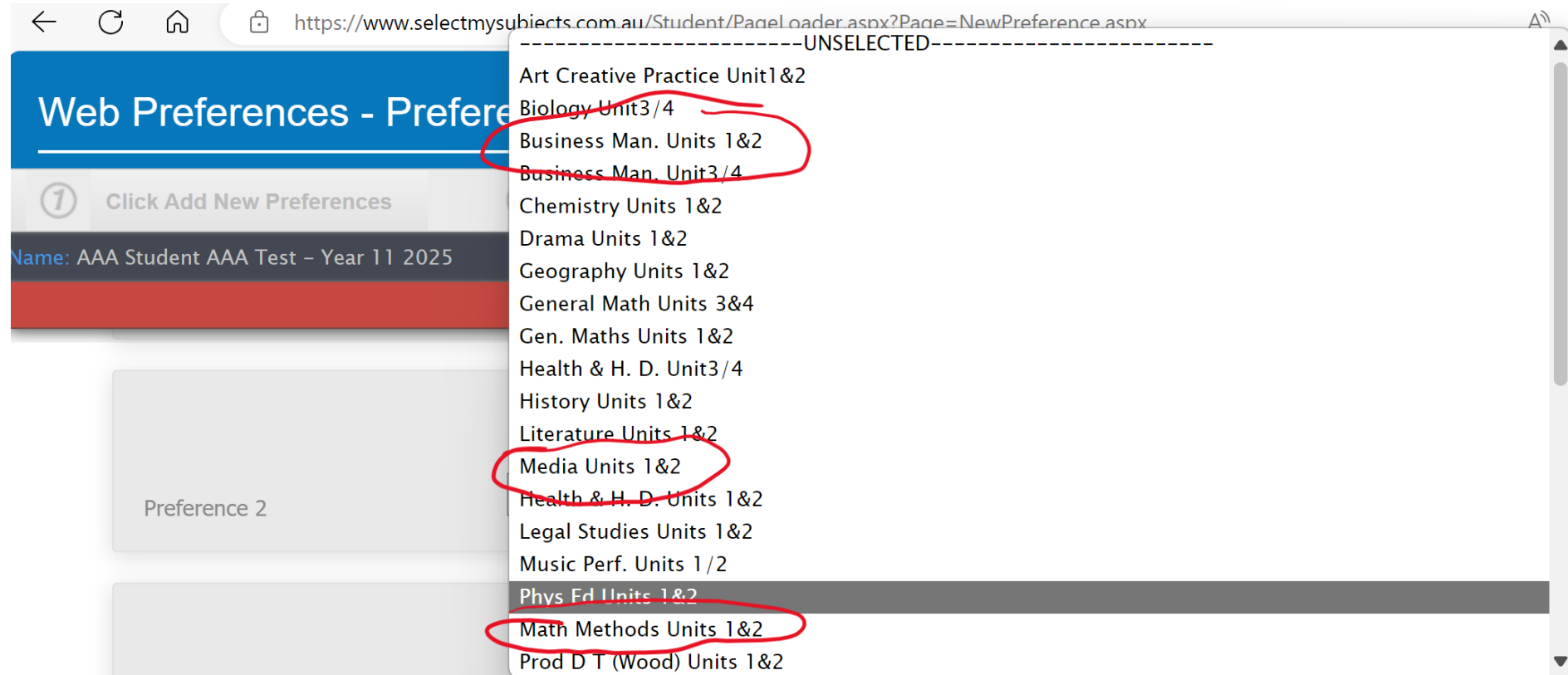

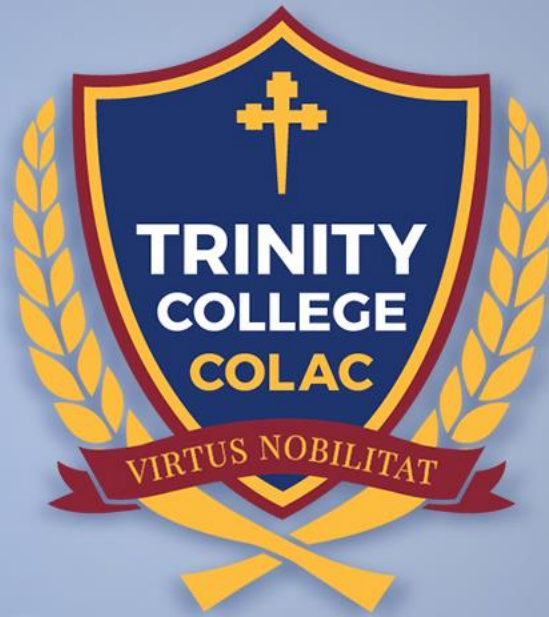
