Trinity College has a firm commitment to working in partnership with parents to enable students to achieve their potential. The Parent Access Module (PAM) provides you with information on a range of areas relating to your child's education, including homework and assessment tasks, school reports, attendance, Parent Teacher Student Interviews, College's daily messages and upcoming events.

HOW TO ACCESS PAM

To access PAM, parents will need a computer, tablet or handheld device (such as a Smart Phone) with web access. You can access PAM via its direct link, via a link on the College website or via a favourite or bookmark you create.



Via favourite or bookmark	When you access PAM for the first time you are strongly advised to create a favourite (or bookmark) to the login page. This will mean you can return to PAM at any time simply by clicking your favourite (or bookmark).

	used. If using Internet Explorer, click the Favourites button (🗷),	
	click Add to Favourites , then click the Add button. If using another	
	browser, consult your Help reference.


STUDENT TIMETABLE
