

TRINITY COLLEGE COLAC - Supervision of Students Information for Parents

Formal supervision of the playground takes place from 8.30am until students begin Homeroom at 8.50am and at all break times until 3.30pm. Trinity College provides additional supervision in the St Joseph's Resource Centre from the end of classes at 3.20pm until 5.00pm for any student who needs or wants to utilise this opportunity.

Students are not permitted inside buildings at breaks, unless it has been declared inclement weather at which time designated indoor areas are supervised.

Bus travellers are supervised until the last bus departs and all students catching buses have left the premises. Due to students from other schools using the bus pick up and drop off area, Trinity College staff supervise this area even when Trinity College students have a student free day.

Staff members are under serious obligations to exercise 'reasonable supervision' when on duty. This supervision is expected to be similar to that provided by caring and concerned family members. Staff on supervision are required to wear a high visibility vest so they are clearly visible to students who may need them.

All staff have first aid qualifications and are trained to manage any emergency that may occur.
